HOUSEHOLD TIPS - PRE-EMERGENT REMINDER

It's time once again for the bi-annual reminder to spray pre-emergent in your yard to avoid those pesky weeds from appearing. The early arrival of warm weather will hasten the growth of these nuisances. Can you believe it hit 90 degrees yesterday?! Take a few minutes this upcoming weekend or perhaps

over Rodeo Break and spray a pre-emergent that is available at your local hardware store to eliminate the growth of unwanted weeds. This is our preferred method to avoid the hassle of picking weeds or even having to grab the Round-Up to knock them down after they appear. Not only will this keep your home's yard looking nice, but it will also keep unwanted letters from your HOA appearing in the mail. An additional tip is to buy a spraying can that hooks to your hose which allows you to automatically mix it with water on the fly while you simply adjust the mixing rate with a dial.
