Mortgage rates have been very volatile over the last couple of weeks and now sit close to their peak levels for the year. This volatility has stemmed in large part from the presidential election, both leading up to the day itself and the forecasts for our economy since the results were decided. The two main factors leading to the rise in interest rates is the anticipation of inflation coupled with a larger federal budget deficit. Rising inflation is negative for mortgage rates and a larger deficit would likely trigger an

increase in the number of bonds issued, thereby increasing supply & decreasing bond prices, causing higher interest rates which typically have an inverse relationship to bond prices. While mortgage rates are still at historically very low rates, a continued rise in rates could spur some buyers on the fence to take action and consider moving up timelines for purchases of homes. It's worth keeping an eye on rates in the near future.

HOUSEHOLD TIPS - CHECK FOR TERMITES
