NARANJA PARK EXPANSION BOND VOTE

Oro Valley's Town Council recently voted unanimously to place a special bond election on the Nov. 7th ballot. At that time it will be up to Oro Valley's voters to decide whether a secondary property tax will be

enacted to pay for the \$17 million expansion of the Naranja Park. There are already two additional multi-use fields that are currently being constructed for the site and this bond would fund three additional fields, four baseball/softball diamonds, a concession stand with restrooms, 4 ramadas, parking lots, a playground, maintenance facility, and infrastructure improvements. This issue has great appeal to many families in the region and some vocal opposition as well, particularly from those still upset about the purchase of the community center & golf courses.
