


IS BUILDING A CUSTOM HOME RIGHT FOR YOU?



HOUSEHOLD TIPS - HANGING A PICTURE

One of the easiest ways to hang a picture, bulletin board, or other type of wall decoration with two mounting holes is to flip it over and stretch a piece of painter's tape between the two holes. Once you've either cut your tape to the right length or marked the position of the holes on the tape, you can simply remove it and adhere the tape to



the wall. Having the tape on the wall allows you to visualize if it's also the right height and you can check it for level. Then simply create the holes for the screws or nails using a hammer or drill and you're all set without the hassle of a tape measure and/or extra holes in your wall.
