








Homes Sold

Buyer's vs. Seller's Market

This graphic explains the key similarities and differences between a buyer's and seller's market; and how these market factors impact each group.

Buyer's Market Seller's Market More people selling homes than buying More people buying homes than selling More homes to choose from Fewer homes to choose from More negotiating power Less negotiating power How it Impacts Buyers Could spend less than asking price Need to be able to close quickly Price restrictions Could spend more than asking price Rarely competing offers Competition from other buyers Buyer's Market Seller's Market More people selling homes than buying Takes more time to sell

How it Impacts Sellers

Fewer offers received Could get lower than asking price May have to make repairs and/or concessions

More people buying homes than selling Home sells quickly Multiple offers likely Could get more than asking price Buyers willing to overlook repairs
