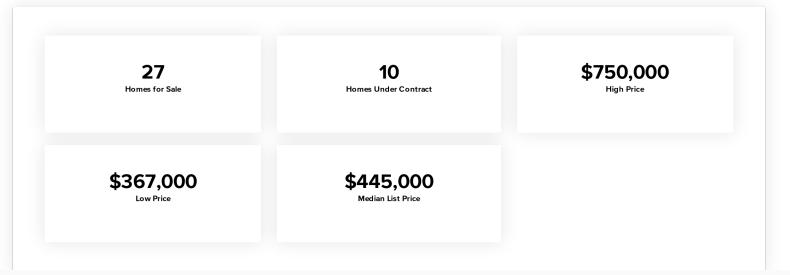

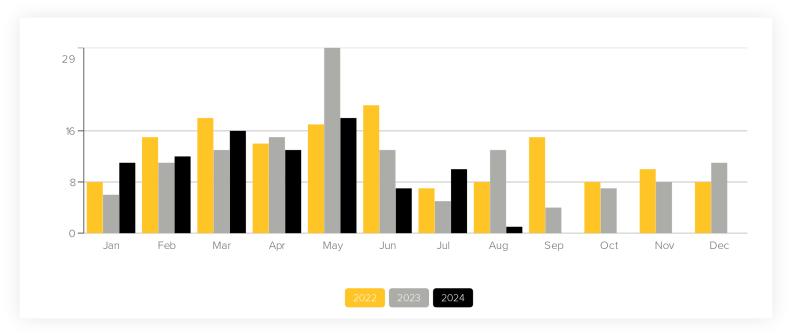
Current Market

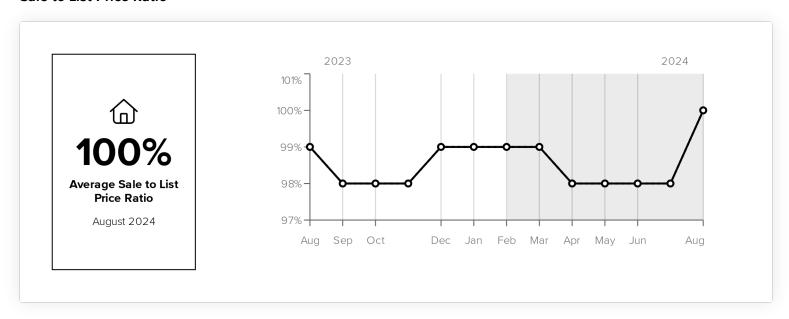




Homes Sold



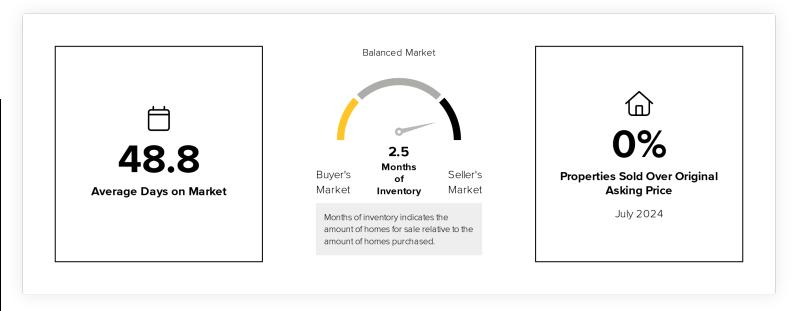
Sale to List Price Ratio

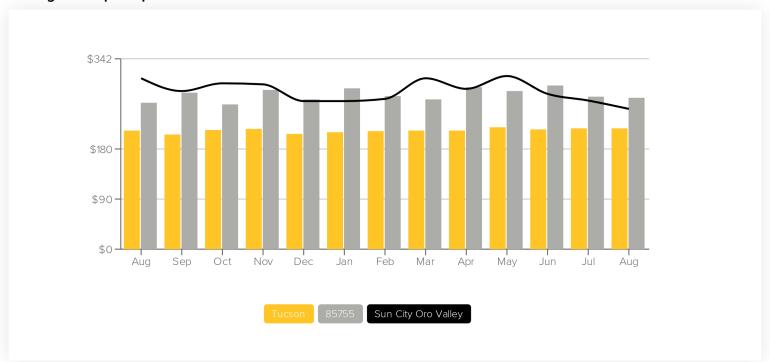
