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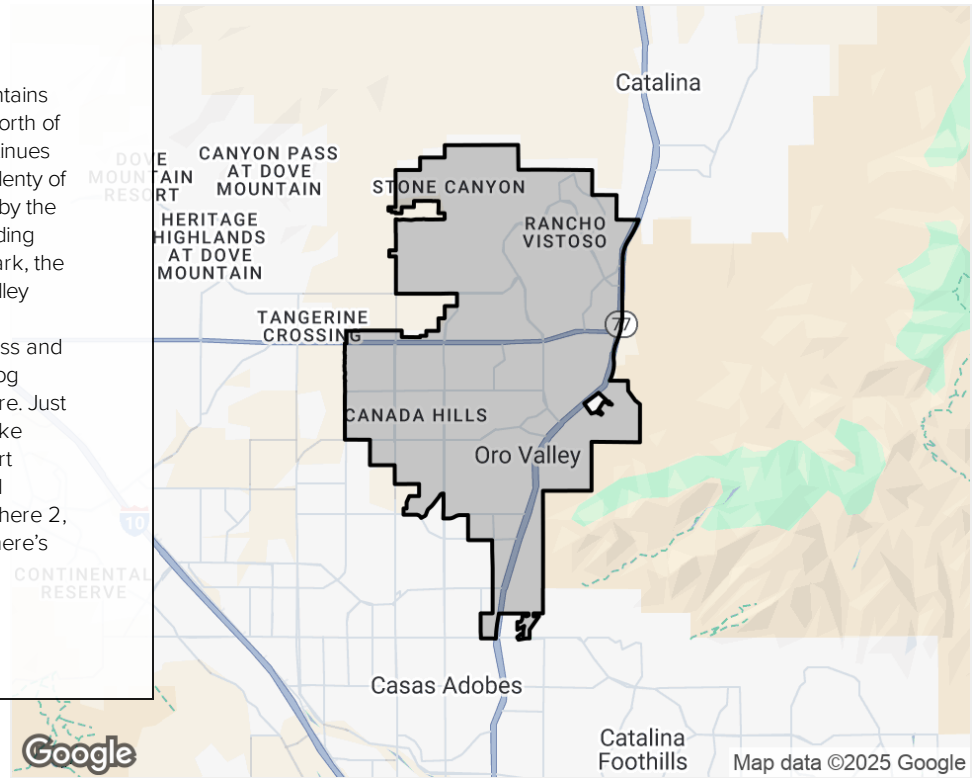

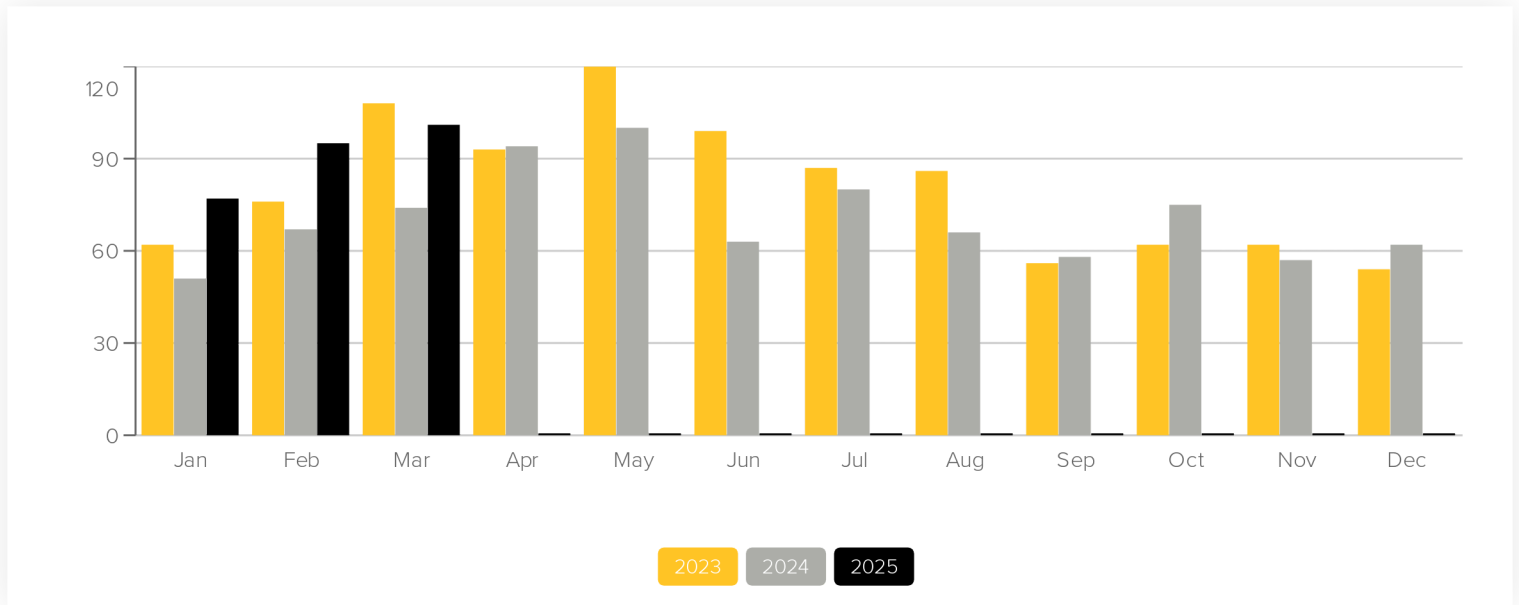
## Current Market

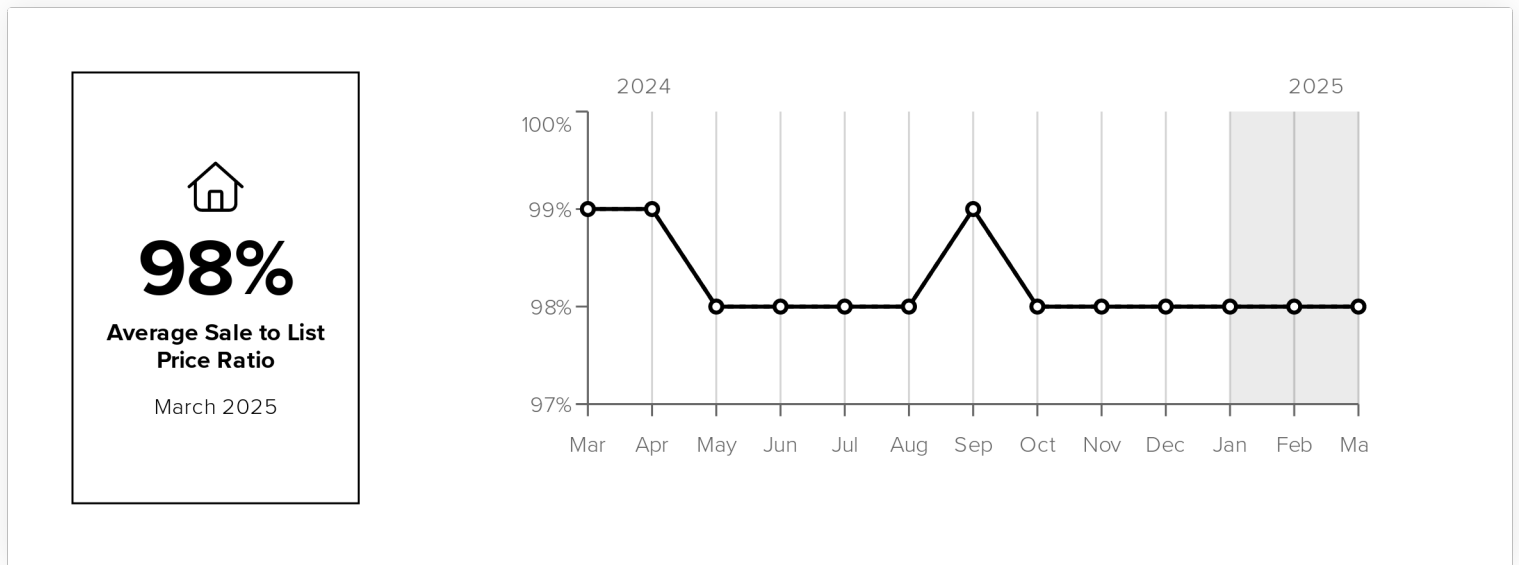

## Buyer's vs. Seller's Market

This graphic explains the key similarities and differences between a buyer's and seller's market; and how these market factors impact each group.

How it Impacts Buyers

**Buyer's Market**  
More people selling homes than buying

- More homes to choose from
- More negotiating power
- Could spend less than asking price
- Price restrictions
- Rarely competing offers

**Seller's Market**  
More people buying homes than selling

- Fewer homes to choose from
- Less negotiating power
- Need to be able to close quickly
- Could spend more than asking price
- Competition from other buyers

How it Impacts Sellers

**Buyer's Market**  
More people selling homes than buying

- Takes more time to sell
- Fewer offers received
- Could get lower than asking price
- May have to make repairs and/or concessions

**Seller's Market**  
More people buying homes than selling

- Home sells quickly
- Multiple offers likely
- Could get more than asking price
- Buyers willing to overlook repairs
