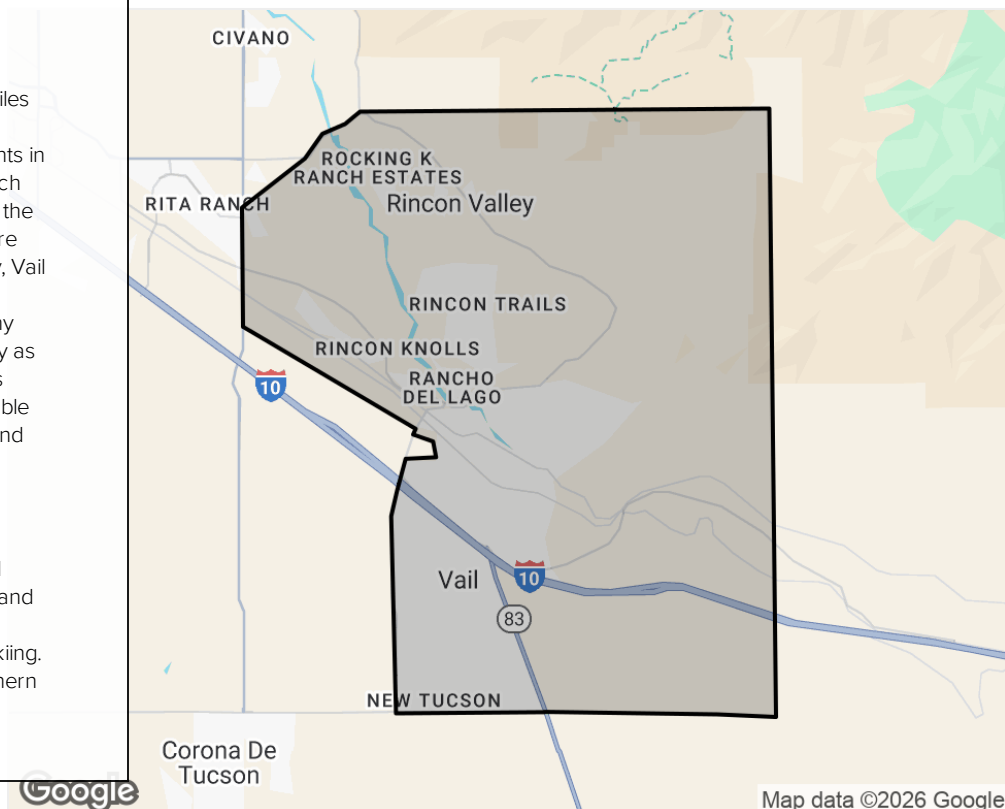

First established as the Empire Cattle Ranch by Edward and Walter Vail in the late 19th century, the town became the storage and loading facility for ore from the successful Helvetia Copper Mine. 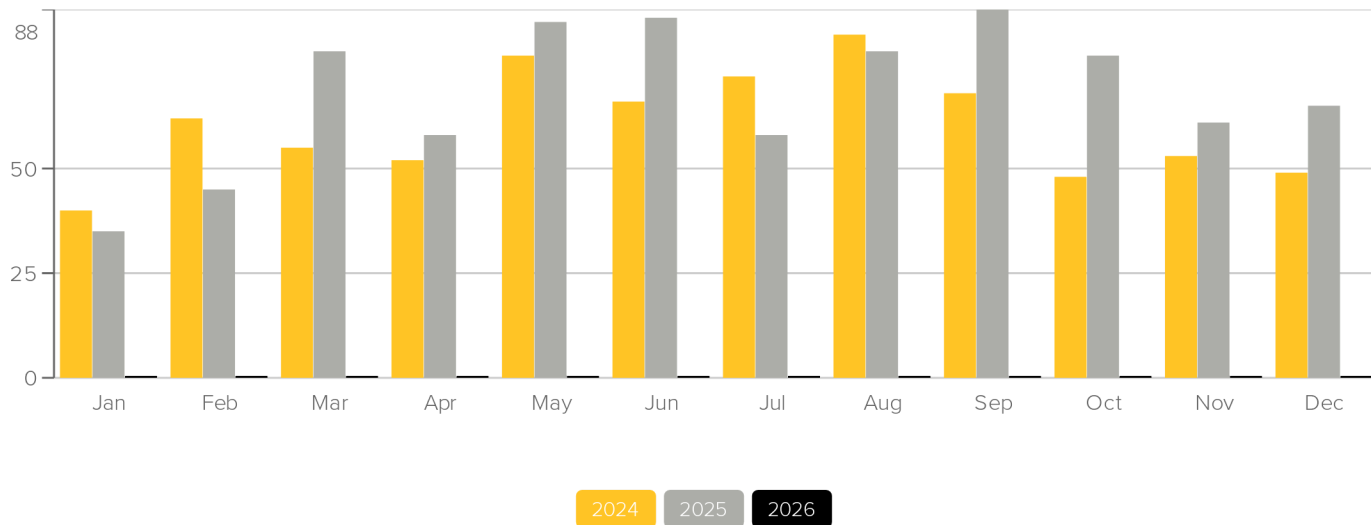

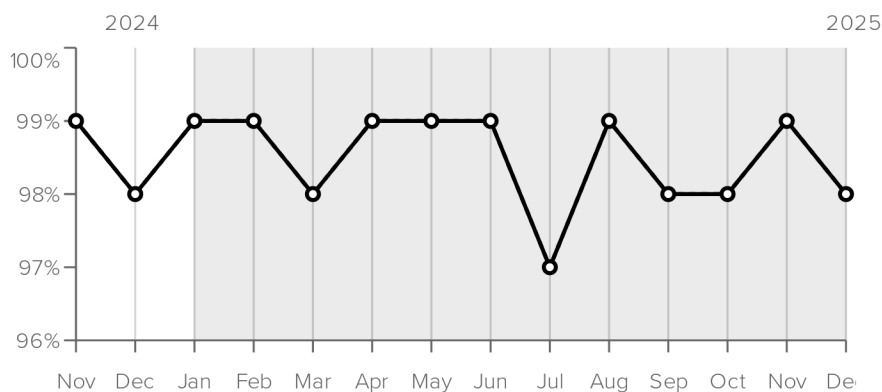

**Homes Sold**

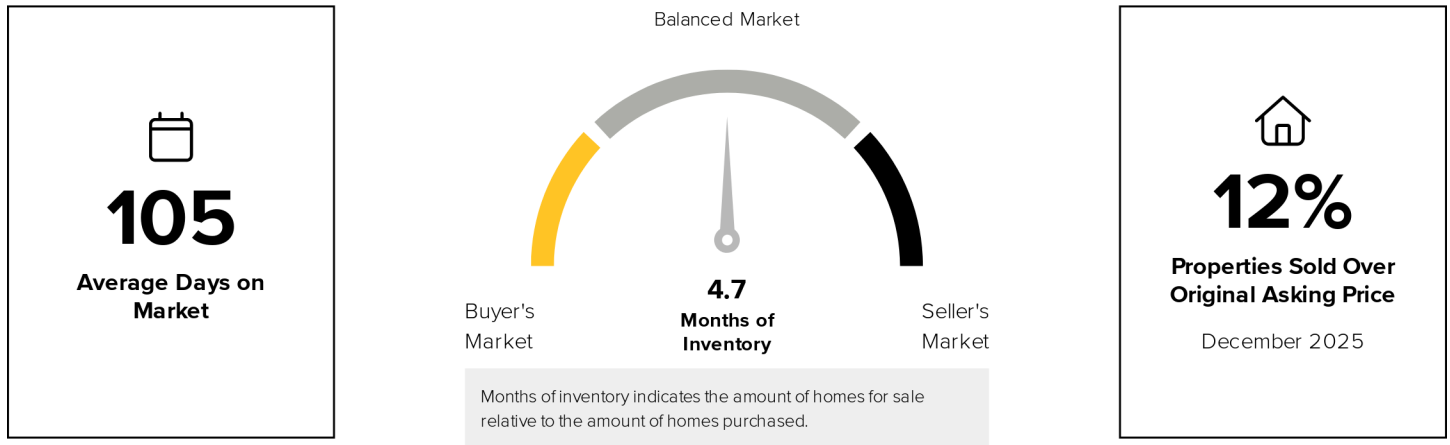


**Sale to List Price Ratio**
