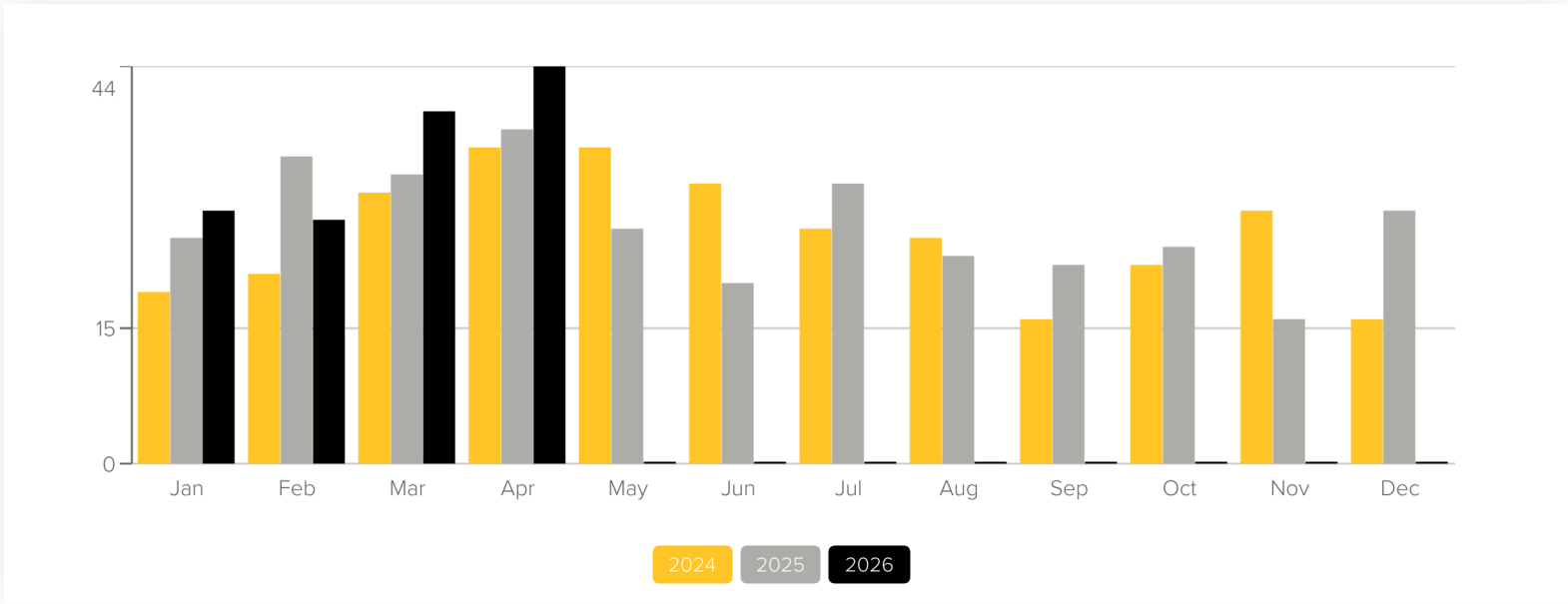

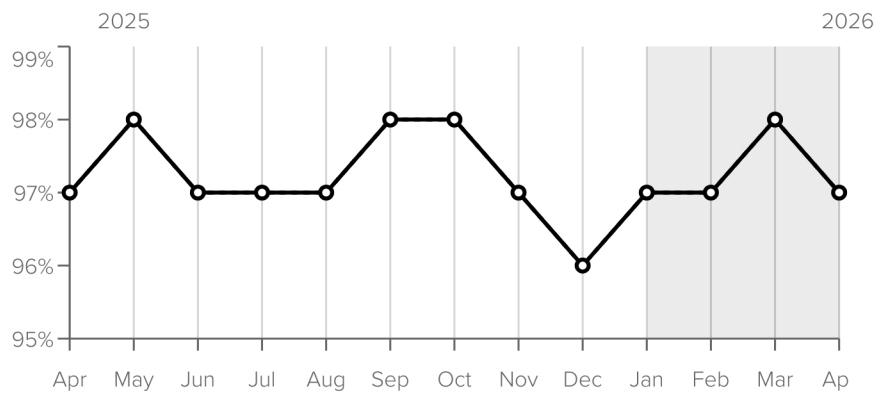
Homes Sold



Sale to List Price Ratio

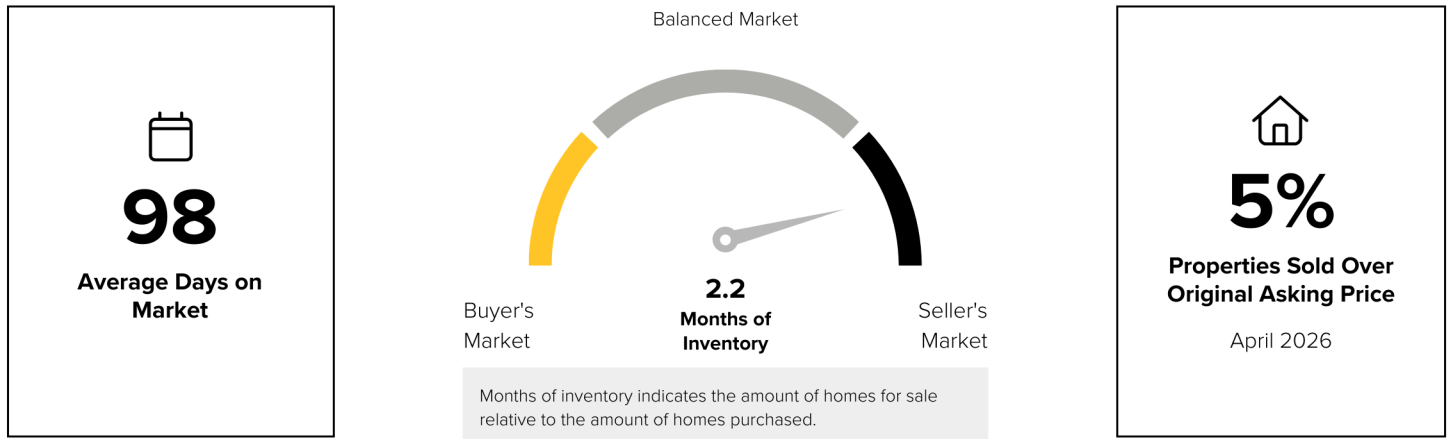

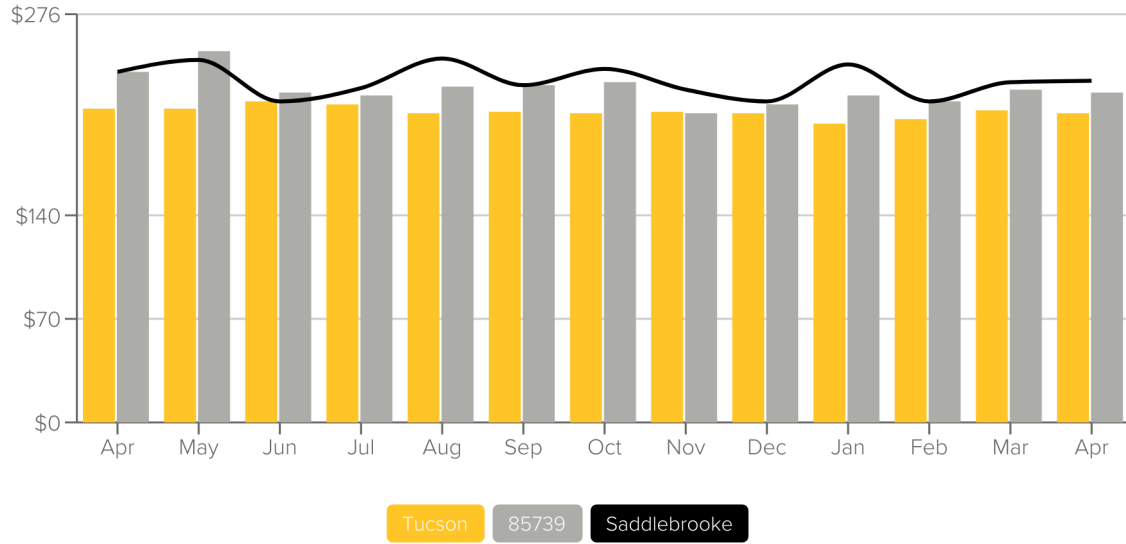




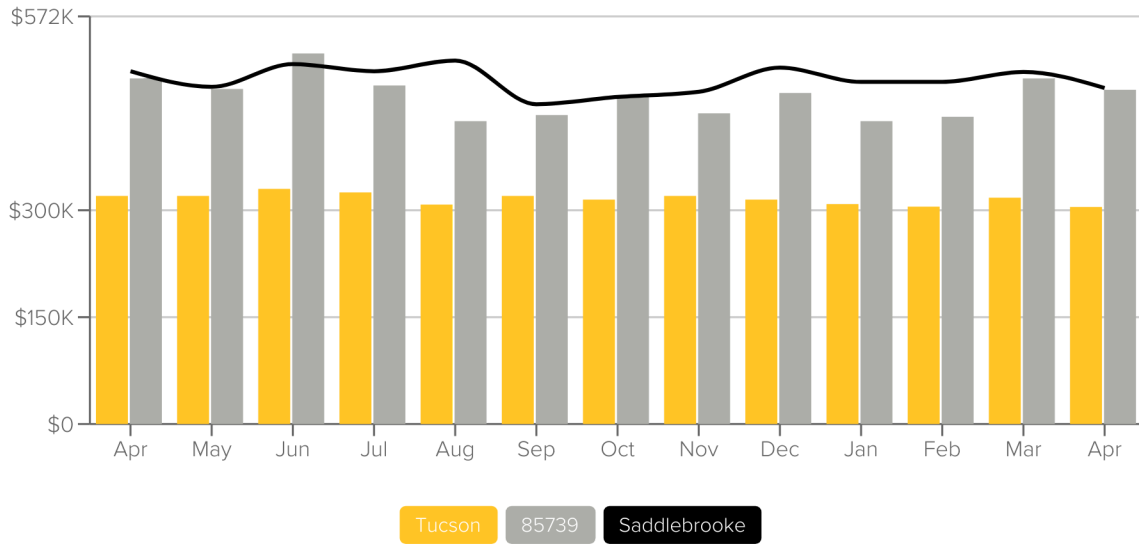
Compare Saddlebrooke to Zip Code and City
